

Recert Notes: Steve Horton

Here is how the Recertification should occur this year:

1. Referees need to sign-up for clinic at the MD Referee website.
2. Referees should register and pass exam online before attending (you will be given exam link when you register for clinic).
3. If you do not pass, you can retake the exam online as many times as is necessary.
4. Passing score is 75%, no exceptions.
5. Referees should, but do not have to, register online.
6. Bring a copy of their Certificate of Completion (exam) to the clinic along with their online Registration Receipt.
 - a. Option 2 is that they will bring their Certificate of Completion to the clinic and register with you at the clinic.

Important notes:

1. You must fill out a registration form at the clinic, even if they registered online. The SRA needs a signed copy for the records.
2. Without BOTH their exam score and registration (online or manual), **YOU WILL NOT BE GIVEN A 2012 BADGE.**
3. If you did not take the exam or if you did not register online before attending, you must do so ASAP (within 30 days). The registration links will remain on the MSR web site after the date of the clinic. You should "register" for the clinic you attended even though it has passed.

Thank you for your cooperation. This is new, there may be a few "glitches, but we will work through them.
