

Referee fees: Current fees will be charged at \$72 for the center, \$44 each line. Therefore, each team pays you \$80 per game. If there is a forfeit, you are to collect the fee from the team that is there and if there are members from the forfeit team, get their money if possible. If you do not get the money let Ross Burbage know ASAP.

Substitutions: Only 7 substitutions per game. No re-entry. Substitutions are allowed according to International rules (i.e. at any stoppage for either team).

Player passes: At the beginning of the game collect 11 passes from the starters. Subs, throughout the game, must present their pass when they enter the game. These passes must be checked against the roster at half time or at the end of the game – making sure player's name is on the roster. DO NOT delay the game any more than necessary but be sure you know the substitutes number when they go in.

Game reports: Game reports are to be emailed to Ross Burbage (Email: reburbage@verizon.net).

You must use official game reports found on USSF website. Visit the Forms page on the Old Line website for links to the game reports. Be sure to include the names of the players who scored. The club awards a trophy at the end of the year to the player with the most goals.

Start time: All games are to start no later than quarter after the hour. There must be 7 players on the field by quarter after or game is forfeited. Do not shorten halves.

Yellow & Red Cards: Make sure cards are given as appropriate. Refusal to give red cards for violent conduct hurts every referee. A fight during the game does not necessitate termination of the game. Termination should only occur if you are afraid for your safety or the safety of the players. You should, however, red card the offender(s) and proceed with the game.

Jewelry: Start enforcing "NO Jewelry". This statement including watches, rings, earrings, and necklaces. This is for the players safety as well as to protect your own liability.

Remember: If there is inclement weather that affects the games Randy Smith will place a recording on his cell phone by 8:00AM with that information.
